

# ABA Cheat Sheet – Minor League 10U

## 2023/2024 Season

| Game Rules                                       | 10Us (Minors)   |
|--|---|
| Innings  | 6 (min 4)   |
| Time (game)                                      | 2 Hours - (No new innings after 1 hour 50 mins)   |
| Mercy rule                                       | 15 after 4 or 10 after 5  |
| Runs per innings (max)                           | 4 runs max (runs above 4 in the final play do not count) for first 5 Innings.   |
| Tied game  | Extra Inns (no max) – one runner (last batter from previous innings) on 2 <sup>nd</sup> base. Batting order starts with the next batter in line-up from last 'at bat'.  |
| Double Headers                                   | Rules to be set by Competition Committee if DHs are scheduled   |
| No. of Players /<br>Line-up cards                | 8 min (9 <sup>th</sup> is auto out) – players not physically present at the plate meeting, should NOT be entered on the line-up card. However, late players (once arrived at the park) can be added as the 9 <sup>th</sup> player or to the substitutions list & play.  |
| Mandatory play                                   | If a regulation game, all players listed on the line up must have at least 6 consecutive outs and 1 at bat.<br><br>A player who fails to meet minimum requirements in a game for any reason must be a starter in their next game, complete what was missed and then their mandatory play before being substituted.<br><br>There are no mandatory play requirements for a game cut short for any reason. |
| Mandatory play – first at bat                    | Batter on his first at bat, must get out or reach home for a run. He may not be substituted during his first at bat, unless injured.  |
| Pitcher max pitches<br>(Note: may finish batter) | Ages 7-8yo = 50, 9-10yo = 75<br>Pitch count limits are determined by a player's age - DOB (not by the grade they play in).<br><br><b>Pitchers must pitch no more than 2 innings or max pitch count (Whichever comes first) in any game.</b>   |
| Pitcher can return?                              | <b>NO</b> - a Pitcher removed from the mound cannot return to pitch.  |
| Pitching in 2 games a day                        | <b>NO</b> – A player cannot pitch in more than one game in a day  |
| Catcher speed up rule?                           | <b>NO</b> – no speed up rule for any player.  |
| Catcher Other                                    | ALL catchers must have a throat guard. All warm-up catchers incl. in bullpens must have a mask. No adults/coaches warming up pitchers. No skull caps.   |
| Headfirst sliding                                | <b>NO</b> – unless returning to a base or in a rundown play.  |
| Infield fly rule                                 | <b>YES</b> - This is a judgement call of an umpire.   |
| Dropped 3 <sup>rd</sup> strike                   | Batter is out   |
| Stealing   | <b>NO</b> – Runner cannot take a lead and cannot leave base until the ball crosses home plate.<br><br><b>Base Runners must not advance at any time on either a passed ball or wild pitch.</b>   |
| Batter's Counts                                  | <b>All batters in this grade will start they're at bat with a 1 strike / 1 ball count.</b>  |
| Balks  | <b>NO</b> – do over   |
| Illegal pitch                                    | <b>YES</b> – dead ball – penalty is a Ball  |



| Game Rules                 | 10Us (Minors)   |
|----------------------------|---|
| Intentional Walks          | <b>YES</b> - Notification must come from the defensive manager only. A player may only be intentionally walked once per game. The appropriate numbers of balls must be added to the pitch count   |
| Ball 4 rule                | If a hitter receives Ball 4, a tee will be used, and the hitter can then hit  |
| Tee usage rule (Ball 4)    | A hitter that becomes a batter/runner, if hitting a fair ball from the Tee, cannot advance past 2 <sup>nd</sup> base on that initial hit.   |
| Hit Batter limit           | Yes – If a pitcher hits (3) batters “on the fly” in one innings, the pitcher will be removed from the mound and will not be eligible to return to pitcher for the remainder of the game.  |
| Batter on-deck circle?     | <b>NO</b> – batters must remain in the dugout   |
| Continuous Batting line-up | Teams must follow a continuous batting order that will include all players on the team roster present for the game, batting in order.<br>Regardless of substitutions and re-entries, each batter must bat in his/her original position in the batting order.  |
| Bats                       | USABAT (Max 33 inches long 2 5/8” barrel) - Refer logo below  |
| Metal Cleats               | No  |
| Balls                      | As approved by the League.  |
| EH / DH allowed?           | <b>NO</b> EH or DH  |
| Max player SIT time        | No player can sit on the bench for more than 2 innings  |
| Re-entry                   | <b>Free</b> Defensive Substitution for all positions except the pitcher. A starting pitcher cannot return to pitch in the same game.  |
| Defence conferences        | Pitcher visits - 2 per inning, 3rd visit a removal; 3 per game, 4th visit a removal.<br>LL Rule 8.06 (d) A coach, granted time to talk to any defensive player will be charged a visit to the pitcher.  |
| Offensive conferences      | One offensive timeout per innings   |
| Coach numbers              | May have up to 3 coaches.   |
| Dugout coach               | 1 Adult coach must be in the dugout at all times. Players can be base coaches but must wear a 2 eared helmet while performing this task.  |
| Protests                   | <b>Playing rule or improper substitution:</b> Must be made before next pitch, play or attempted play. <b>Mandatory Play:</b> As soon as the facts become known.<br><b>Ineligible pitcher or player:</b> As soon as facts become known, but before either teams’ next game.  |
| No Foreign Substances      | Under the new guidelines, any pitcher, fielder, manager, coach, club personnel, club committee member / volunteer who possesses or applies foreign substances in violation of the rules will be ejected from the game and automatically suspended in accordance with the rules and past precedent.<br>Umpires may perform checks at any time.<br><b>Rule 3.01 states that “no player shall intentionally discolour or damage the ball by rubbing it with soil, rosin, paraffin, liquorice, sandpaper, emery paper or other foreign substance.” Rule 6.02(c) expands on that rule by stating, among other things, that a pitcher may not “apply a foreign substance of any kind to the ball;” “deface the ball in any manner;” throw a shine ball, spit ball, mud ball or emery ball; “have on his person, or in his possession, any foreign substance;” or “attach anything to his hand, any finger or either wrist (e.g., Band-Aid, tape, Super Glue, bracelet, etc.).</b> |
